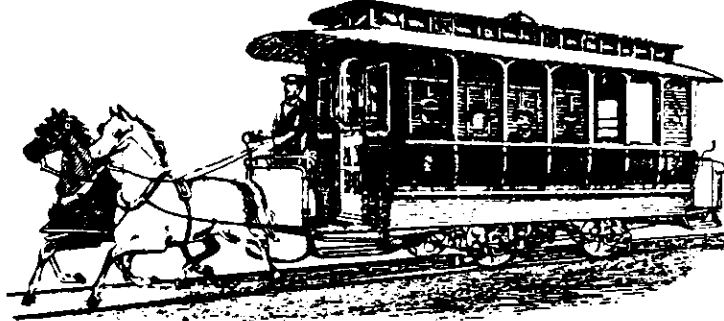

Carettes were horsedrawn vehicles that resembled streetcars but ran on tires. One is pictured on page 22 of Volume II of our catalogue. They were used in the 1890's in several cities. This is one nice token!

The Charlotte, NC, token was pictured on page 132 of the November 1998 Fare Box. It is worth \$1 toward parking at onstreet meters, participating garages and lots, or a ride on Charlotte Transit or the trolley. The "jsb" on obverse is the initials of the designer of the token. This issue will be supplied to members of the New Issues Service. There is another similar token in solid brass, sold for \$4.95, strictly as a souvenir.

The CT Presentation Piece was mentioned in the January issue. Only 50 of them were struck. Most were reserved for members of the trolley museum, but a few were made available to AVA members for a \$50 donation to the Museum.

Re PTMS-3099, apparently, SENTRY SECURITY CONTROLS changed their name and added new stock tokens.

Don Smith advises that ON-3740-C was discontinued on October 19, 1998. The hospital went under Regional at that time and the name was changed to the PORT ARTHUR SITE of THUNDER BAY REGIONAL HOSPITAL.

ON-3895-E has been in use since at least 1993 when Don obtained his specimen.

PTUN-3104 is showing up in unusual quantities in the Pittsburgh, PA area. Vic Nolan is trying to determine which branch and variety is used where.

Don Smith sent me pix of two varieties being used on the Canadian piece. Altho side by side the difference is noticable, there is not enough distinction to make sub varieties.

idealab! located in Pasedena, CA is using PTMS-3082-F.

Vic Nolan sent an interesting article from a Pittsburgh newspaper. Certain streets in that city have 750 electronic parking meters with slots that accept pre-paid debit cards. The project is under study and the city will decide whether to implement the system.
