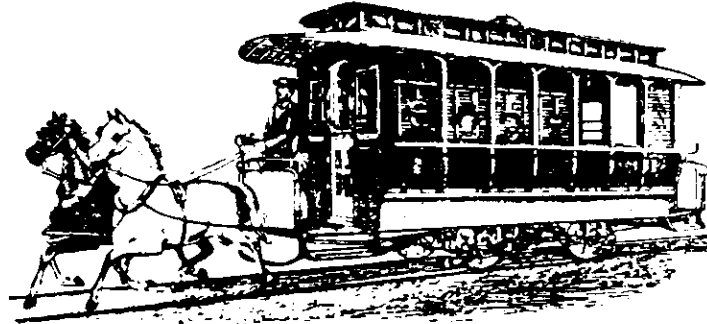

June 21. The Annual Convention of the American Vecturist Association will be held August 12-15 at the Sheraton Old Towne Hotel (800 Rio Grande Blvd NW, Albuquerque, NM). Get off I-40 at the Rio Grande Blvd exit and go 2 blocks south. You should make your own hotel reservations by calling the hotel at 505-843-6300, and be sure to say you're with the A.V.A. to get special reduced rates. The registration fee for this convention will be \$80, which includes everything, and should be sent to Convention Chairman Joel Reznick at P.O. Box 116, Wheeling, IL 60090-0116. Hope to see you there!

I shall be leaving for California about July 6, returning about August 21, so mail that would arrive during that period should be addressed to "J.M. Coffee - c/o H.V. Ford - 43 Arroyo Drive - Moraga, CA 94556. I'll be leaving Moraga about August 3 to take in our Albuquerque convention, stopping in Los Angeles on the way for a couple of days.

Keith Haney reports that RTA in Corpus Christi, TX, has taken some of the seagull tokens (TX 220 A) and painted them five different colors, for five different high schools. This was back before 1994, and since then all the seagull tokens, including the painted ones, were smelted. A few of the painted ones have been turning up, though. Interesting situation.

William Sowell reports that Fort Worth, TX, has issued a new brass 16mm solid token, a very nice one, and we're trying to persuade them to pick out the new ones so we can supply our N.I.S. Also a new brass token for Wheeling, WV, about 29mm, which is in current use and we're confident we can get a supply for N.I.S.

John Byars reports a nice old one: 33mm aluminum, "YELLOW CAB / PHONE / GRAND 700 / MILWAUKEE, WIS. // GOOD FOR / 50¢ / IN TRADE / IN A YELLOW CAB". Very elaborate scroll work. John's token has a 4mm hole at 12 o'clock, which may or may not have been put there by the taxi company.

Last month on page 48 I described an especially attractive club tour token that had been made for the Electric Railway Historical Assn. of Southern California, and were to be used for a special preview run of the new Red Line in Los Angeles. As they had only 250 made, it was iffy about whether any would be left over for AVA members. As it turned out, there weren't any left. As Mr. Heller, vice-president of the club, wrote: "If we had held tokens back for your members we might have had unsold ones so we decided to see how they went at the opening event and then let you know if there were any left. We went into the event with 80 tokens of the original 250 and they were all gone at \$5 each by 10 a.m. the first of the two days." So the two he sent me are about all that were let loose, so to speak. Next token will be for an event in March, 2000, and I think they will order more that time. Incidentally the opening day of the line to the public drew 110,000 riders the first day and 100,000 the 2nd day...of course it was free those two days. Hope they can maintain its popularity after people have to pay to ride it.

Louis Crawford reports a 38mm green plastic from Plainview, MN: HIAWATHA-LAND / TRANSIT / VALUE \$1 // (same as obverse). This is a dial-a-ride operation and we're working on getting a supply.

Louis also came up with a 25mm square green fibre token: SHARE / THE / RIDE // POCATELLO / KRAFT / EMPLOYEES. I vaguely remember seeing this one a few years back and could never learn anything about the token, if it was actually good for a ride or what. Seems likely it was a ride token. The fibre composition indicates (but does not prove) that it was a World War II issue.

Mike Jones reports on the Tom Wall mail bid auction that included an example of IA 380 H. Back in the July 1998 Fare Box I quoted Dick Grinolds' publication saying some of these had been found. Be that as it may, the token realized \$230 in Tom's auction. There is something special about a depotel, isn't there.

Louis Crawford also came up with another waterslide token. This is a 38mm blue plastic with silver lettering, 4mm thick: VALID AT THE FOLLOWING REGIONAL PARKS / CUCAMONGA GUASTI / GLEN HELEN / LAKE GREGORY / YUCAIPA // GOOD FOR ONE / WATERSLIDE RIDE / SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY / REGIONAL / PARKS [in logo]. This is a \$1 token used, as it says, at several locations in southern California. But the accompanying publicity puts it thus: "5 ride waterslide token \$4.00...single token ride \$1.00." So we wonder if there is also another token, good for 5 rides and costing \$4. We're looking into it to see about securing a supply.

Finally, there's a tricky one used in my backyard here in Massachusetts, one of those special use things that sometimes are hard nuts to crack. When Hal Ford is here, we'll drive over and see if we can pry some loose for our members.

Bill Sowell just received, from England of all places, a 29mm brass token from Cerritos, California: "City of Cerritos / Incorporated April 24, 1956 [in logo] // One Fare * One Fare * One Fare * One Fare * / COW (incuse) / Cerritos on Wheels / Transit System (incuse)" I think this wins the contest to see how many times "One Fare" can appear on a token. Nice token. Cerritos is near Los Angeles, and we're working on getting a supply. I'll be near there early in August and may pay them a visit if we haven't got our quantity by then.

Don't know if I mentioned this before. There are 2 unlisted tokens now in use in Lowell, just 40 miles or so north of Boston. When Hal Ford is here we'll get up there and get some (I trust). Be a nice short trip to help break in the new car.

DIP, SWIPE & SMART TRANSIT CARDS

In case you hadn't noticed, major cities all across this great country of ours have been adding a new fare medium, a plastic card usually with some kind of magnetic stripe. Even the flimsy paper transfer has been giving way to a paper/magnetic card version. Some cities, for example Chicago, have even stopped accepting tokens. In that city, token agents have become customer service agents, and spend most of their time OUTSIDE the booth!

These cards are an evaluation of Credit and Debit cards. They contain either a quantity of rides or value. Some even have an "unlimited" value as opposed to the forerunner the "Flash Pass." As you might expect, there are a few monthly "trade" publications that cater to the industry, e.g. Credit Card Management, Card Technology.

Transit agencies have discovered that firms will pay to get their advertisements on the back of these new cards. This makes it difficult for a "collector" to keep up with all the new issues. Varieties are fine, but several NEW cards a month is just plain ridiculous.

Here in New York City, NYCT (New York City Transit; they no longer have any AUTHORITY...(in their name that is) recently came out with a list of the first 77 MetroCards with unique graphics (September 1994 thru January 1999). Some were public service designs, e.g. the Staten Island Ferry, Brooklyn Bridge, but most were commercial, e.g. Emigrant Savings Bank came out with an attractive set of eight with ethnic themes. Anyhow, they asked their customers to vote on their favorite. The winner got a set of all 77. I asked for a consolation prize for identifying four that didn't make their list (3 variations on sets, and one they totally missed). I got a polite thank you.

Through friends I've made on the Internet my collection now includes examples from a number of cities outside New York City, e.g. Chicago, Washington DC, Atlanta, Boston, Phoenix, Minneapolis, Buffalo, Connecticut (same card for various cities), PATH (NJ), Montreal, Tokyo, London, Antwerp (Belgium).


The newest type of variation is the Smart Card. It's a little thicker than the dip/swipe card because it contains a computer chip that makes it SMARTER than the others. Washington DC has a working system; Chicago will be live soon and NYC may not be far behind. They're studying the card (I think they just want to see if it works at Chicago and Washington). I was able to obtain a Chicago smart "Go Card" that was being used for testing. The Washington card would cost me \$25 to obtain (\$5 for the card and \$20 of initial value) that's a little steep for me so I'm hoping someone will want to trade one for something like a set of four NYC Yankee MetroCards.

I think John Coffee would be sympathetic to a dip/swipe/smart card sub-group, similar to our car wash token group, but someone needs to be willing to run it. At present I can't take on that role, but would be more than happy to work with anyone who would.



NOTES BY HAROLD V. FORD

The Arkadelphia, AR, listing was mentioned last month. Comparing the rubbing with one of the already listed AR 15 B, it appears there is no incuse inscription on this new discovery.

We lack any background info about the LA 640 A token. Louis Crawford notes that "LA" is handwritten on his specimen.

The Miami County (Ohio) Community Action Council operates two systems. The Piqua Taxi Service token was good for a flat rate of \$1.20 per ride in Piqua plus two miles. Previous fares could run as much as \$3.45 per ride. The local authority lacked any specimens of this token as of late May. The Miami County Transit Service in Troy, OH, uses four different plastics. Ohio 810 D \$1.20 is for a paid-in-advance ride. OH 870 E cost 60¢ and is a reduced fare token for handicapped and over age 63. Due to a very limited supply the New Issues Service will not handle these tokens.

Keith Haney obtained a supply of TX 220 C for the N.I.S. The regular adult fare in Corpus Christi is 75¢, but 220 B and C are sold at a discount to social service agencies, and are distributed to their clients to get them to come back. They go out, they don't come back in the fare box!

The Morgantown, WV, token was mentioned last month. Cash fare is 75¢, with tokens sold at 15 for \$10. Louis has obtained a supply for the N.I.S.
